

2023 Mamacita 80% Vermentino, 20% Muscat Applegate Valley AVA

Our favorite celebratory bubbles are back and beautiful, rolling out from our early sunny harvest and ready for

holiday celebrations. From two well known (to us) sites in the Applegate Valley, Layne and Four Diamonds, this blend of Vermentino and Muscat is brimming with grapefruit and Meyer lemon, golden kiwifruit, papaya, starfruit, racy acid, fresh salinity, and of course, bubbles. We are so excited to be able to release the fruits of this year in time for this years holidays. 2023 was an unpredictable growing season, with a late start, consistently pleasant summer weather, a couple of heat spikes, and an early harvest. The vibrancy of fruit and balance of structure in this wine is a great example of what to expect from the Oregon 2023 vintage as a whole.



Grape Varieties: 80% Vermentino, 20% Muscat

Vineyards: Layne and Four Diamonds

Final pH: 3.16

Final TA: 6.3 g/L

Alc. By Vol.: 11.5%



Winemaking: Fruit was direct pressed and moved to stainless steel, racked off lees three times, and fermented outside under sunny skies. We watched sugar levels closely and chilled the tank when we reached the correct levels, then bottled it up by hand, again, outside under sunny skies. This wine captures the warmth and sunshine of the vintage beautifully.
