

## 2025 Mamacita 56% Vermentino, 44% Zibibbo (Muscat of Alexander) Applegate Valley AVA

Our favorite celebratory bubbles are back and beautiful, rolling out from our early sunny harvest and ready for holiday celebrations. From two well known (to us) sites in the Applegate Valley, Four Diamonds and Cole Family, this blend of Vermentino and Zibibbo is brimming with peaches, grapefruit and Meyer lemon, golden kiwifruit, papaya, starfruit, racy acid, fresh salinity, and of course, bubbles. We are so excited to be able to release the fruits of this year in time for this years holidays. 2025 was a sunny, warm and mild growing season with cool evenings in the higher elevations of the Applegate Valley (about 1500 feet). The vibrancy of fruit and balance of structure in this wine is a great example of what to expect from the Oregon 2025 vintage as a whole.

### Technical Information

**Grape Varieties:** 56% Vermentino, 44% Zibibbo  
(Muscat of Alexander)

**Vineyards:** Four Diamonds and Cole Family

**Final pH:** 3.12

**Final TA:** 6.4 g/L

**Alc. By Vol.:** 12.4%

**Winemaking:** Fruit was direct pressed and moved to stainless steel, racked off lees three times, and fermented spontaneously. We watched sugar levels closely and chilled the tank when we reached the correct levels, then bottled it up by hand, under crown cap. This wine captures the warmth and sunshine of the vintage beautifully.
