

2020 Mimi Loves Boppa Applegate Valley

At one point Brianne's parents had actual first names, but after 15 years of being Grandparents everyone in the family calls them by their grandchild bestowed names of Mimi and Boppa. This wine is an exotic little number, it is completely dry but with deep floral and fruity characteristics. A hint of ginger spice, a lot of stone fruit, and some very pretty flowers all show up. This very limited bottling (only 24 cases produced) came into being as we allowed one barrel of Muscat to age for a year, and it was bottled in honor of Brianne's parents 46th anniversary.

Technical Information

Grape Varietals: 100% Muscat

Vineyards: Layne Vineyard

Final pH: 3.34

Final TA: 5 g/L

Alc. By Vol.: 12%

Winemaking: Muscat grapes were pressed and cold settled in stainless steel, then racked to a neutral barrel where it slowly went through native fermentation and malolactic fermentation. The wine was racked out one year later and bottled by hand.
